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ADMISSION POLICY FALL 2020 **ADMISSION REGULATIONS**

1. Admission to various classes in LGU Lahore is granted on merit strictly and in accordance with the rules, regulations, policies and procedures of the University. Applications for admission will be accepted according to the schedule notified and no application form will be accepted after the last date except with the special permission of the Vice Chancellor. After the completion of the necessary stages of admission, the list of successful candidates will be displayed /uploaded on University Notice Board and LGU Website. Students, who fail to pay all the dues by the due date their right of admission will be forfeited.
2. University authorities can reject any candidate's application for admission on the ground of unbecoming character or conduct. The students of this university or any other, who were found guilty of misconduct or indiscipline and were consequently punished or fined, shall not be considered for admission.
3. The applications of the students who are found to have an unbecoming character and conduct will be rejected. No appeal can be filed against the rejected student.
4. After the admission of a candidate, if it comes to the knowledge of the University Authorities at any stage that the documents submitted by the candidate for admission carry a misstatement, or fake, or there is an error in these documents, that may affect his/her admission.
5. Candidates who apply on sports and special category bases are requested to submit a separate Sports Form/Special Category Form along with the General Admission Form separately for each Game/Activity/Category to which they wish to apply. Along with this, "SPORTS BASIS/SPECIAL CATEGORY BASIS" in block letters on the top of the General Admission Form.

Admission Criteria

6. Admissions will strictly be conducted on merit, entry test (Testing system will be prepared by Dean / HoD) and interview basis where applicable. Interview will be conducted by HOD under the supervision of Dean of Faculty.

Eligibility Criteria

BS/BBA (4 Years Programs)

7. The applicant (male/female) applying for admission in B.S (Hons) and all other undergraduate classes must have intermediate or equivalent degree with at least 50% marks for all subjects of faculty of Computer Sciences & IT, faculty of Basic Sciences, Social Sciences and Languages.
8. All interested students of A Level must submit their equivalence certificate.
9. Total marks for the purpose of merit shall be computed as given below:-
Total marks = $1/4^{\text{th}}$ of matriculation + FA /FSc. ICS / I.Com / DAE.
10. Maximum gap would be for three years from completion of previous HSSC.

Note: Merit list of minimum 15 students of (BS/BBA) programmes will be displayed.

MBA (2 years)

11. The applicant (male/female) applying for admission to MBA must have 16 years business education or BBA (Hons) with at least 50% marks or 2.50 CGPA 50% in GAT-General and 60% marks in university test.

MS / M.Phil.

12. A candidate seeking admission in MS/M.Phil program should have completed sixteen years of education or 4 years of education after FA/FSc/A level or equivalent.

13. The GAT-General with a minimum 50% cumulative score will be required at the time of admission to M.Phil/M.S. The GAT General Test score is valid for a period of two years.

14. A candidate must have 50% marks (under annual system) or 2.5 out of 4.00 CGPA (under semester system) in BS/BA programs.

15. A candidate working in Government / Semi Government / Private Institutions may apply. Such candidates shall have to submit "No Objection Certificate" from the head of the institution where they are working.

16. There is no age limit for admission to MS/M.Phil programs.

Note: Merit list of minimum 10 students of M.Phil programmes will be displayed.

Ph.D Eligibility Criteria

17. For admission into the PhD minimum CGPA 3.0 (out of 4.0 in the semester system) or first division (in the annual system) in MPhil / MS /Equivalent is required.

18. In the case GAT Subject test, the minimum 60% score will be accepted for admission to PhD program.

19. If the test is not available in NTS subject list, then a University Committee consisting of at least three PhD faculty members in the subject area and approved by the HEC will conduct the Test at par with GAT Subject Test and qualifying score for this will be 70% score.

20. A candidate working in Government / Semi Government or Private Institutions may apply. Such candidates shall have to submit "No Objection Certificate" from the head of the institution where they are working.

21. There is no age limit for admission to Ph.D program.

22. Merit list of minimum 05 students of Ph.D programmes will be displayed.

Note

1. The percentage .5 and above will be considered as 1 as like 49.5% and above will be considered as 50%.

2. Vice Chancellor may use his authority for the admission in exceptional cases.

3. MPhil and PhD admissions are according to available PhD faculty of relevant departments.

4. Minimum 05 students are required for starting the class of MPhil & PhD.

5. Supervisors of MPhil and Ph.D. scholars will be allocated on the basis of HEC policy.

Quota for Applicants

1. Quota for disabled persons 2% seats (in whole university / Faculty /Department).

2. Children / spouses / real brothers or sisters of the LGU teachers, serving or retired (excluding teachers on deputation/part-time teachers) with a service of not less than 2 years. This is also applicable to self-supporting afternoon/evening programs 2.5%.

3. Foreign students (whose names are recommended by the Ministry of Education, Govt. of Pakistan, according to the prescribed procedure) 1%.

4. Son/Daughter of martyrs of Army, War disabled, serving and retired army personnel subject to the recommendation /certificate by the relevant body. A certificate of martyrdom issued by the G.H.Q Adjutant General Branch should be attached along with the recommendation letter is 50%.

5. Outstanding Sports Persons (Selected on the recommendations of the Special Committee appointed by the Vice Chancellor for the said purpose) 2%.
6. Students having distinction in Co-curricular activities will be selected by committee appointed by the Vice-Chancellor for this purpose. Activities to be decided by the admission committee 2%.
7. Students nominee from Azad Jammu and Kashmir (to be nominated by the respective Nomination Board and recommended by the Federal Govt.) 4 seats in the whole University (other than those disciplines being offered at Azad Jammu and Kashmir University).
8. Students nominee from Gilgit-Balistan (to be nominated by the respective Nomination Board and recommended by the Federal Govt.) 5 seats in the whole university (other than those disciplines which are not offered in the Karakorum University of Gilgit-Baltistan).
9. Students nominee from KPK (to be nominated by International the respective Nomination Board and recommended by the Federal Govt.) 10 seats in the whole university (other than those disciplines which are being offered in KPK).
10. Students from Baluchistan having domicile and education throughout from Baluchistan are eligible only. (Applications are acceptable directly from the candidates of Baluchistan). 4 seats in the whole University (Other than those disciplines being offered at any Institutions of Baluchistan).
11. Students from Sindh having domicile and education throughout from Sindh are eligible only. (Applications are acceptable directly from the candidates of Sindh). 4 seats in the whole University (Other than those disciplines being offered at any Institutions of Sindh).

Fee Concession

Students can apply for fee concession in the different categories after taking the admission in LGU.

Admission on Self Finance

Eligibility criteria for self-finance students.

Candidates applying on self-finance basis, eligibility criteria is relaxed till 5% for all BS programs offered in the university.
