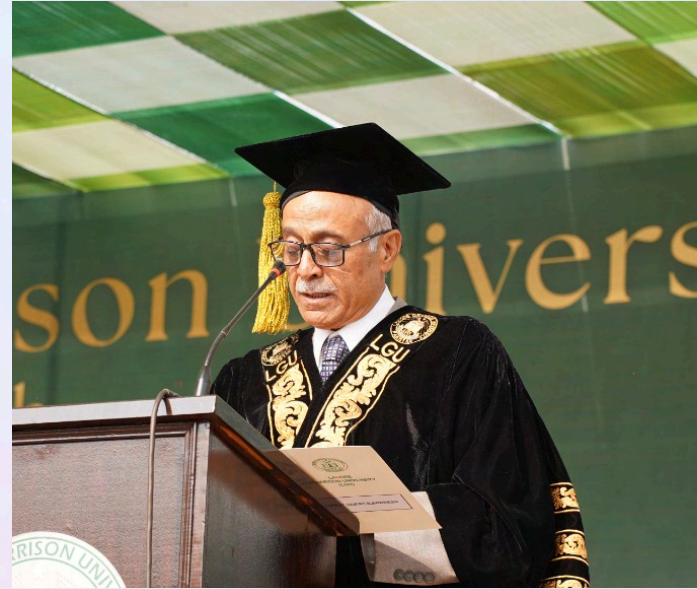

Interactive Talk on **"FREEDOM OF FREEWILL"**



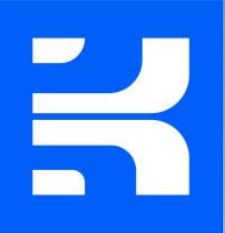

The session provided a unique opportunity for the LGU community to delve into this profound philosophical concept.

Muhammad Waqar Raza, a remarkable polymath who is a physician, Professor of Microbiology, scientist, and published fiction writer (Oxymoron), brought a unique blend of expertise to the discussion. He introduced a novel framework for understanding human freewill, synthesizing his scientific and medical background with interdisciplinary insights.

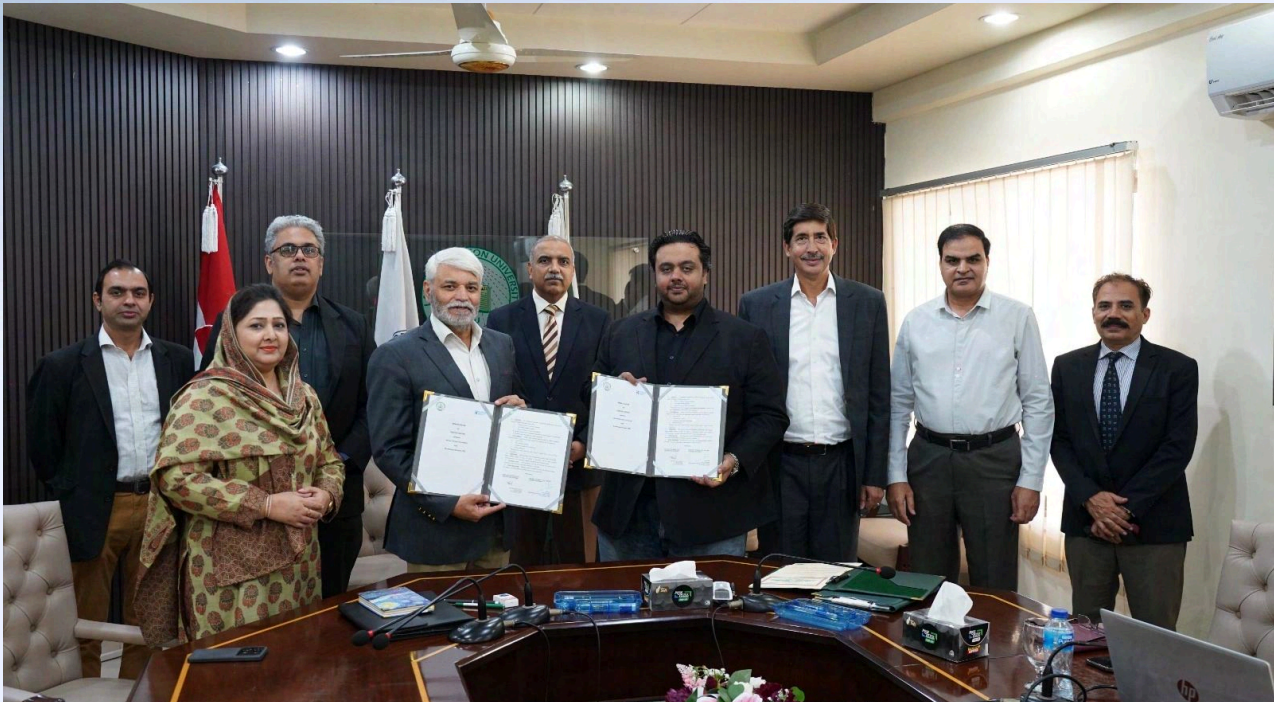


The concepts of Qada (Divine Decree, the universal and ultimate blueprint) and Qadar (Divine Pre-measurement or Destiny, the measure and manner in which the blueprint unfolds) reveal that the fundamental nature of creation operates within predetermined ranges or limits set by divine will. However, this framework emphasizes that our freewill plays a significant and influential role in determining where we land within those divinely set boundaries, affirming that human choices are both real and consequential.

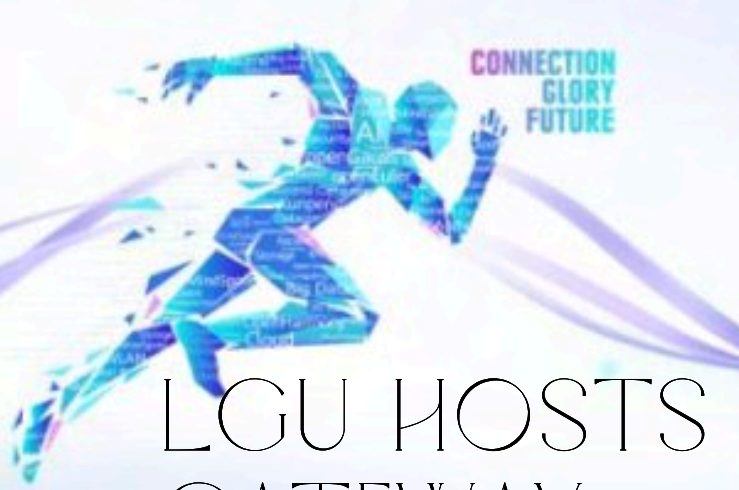

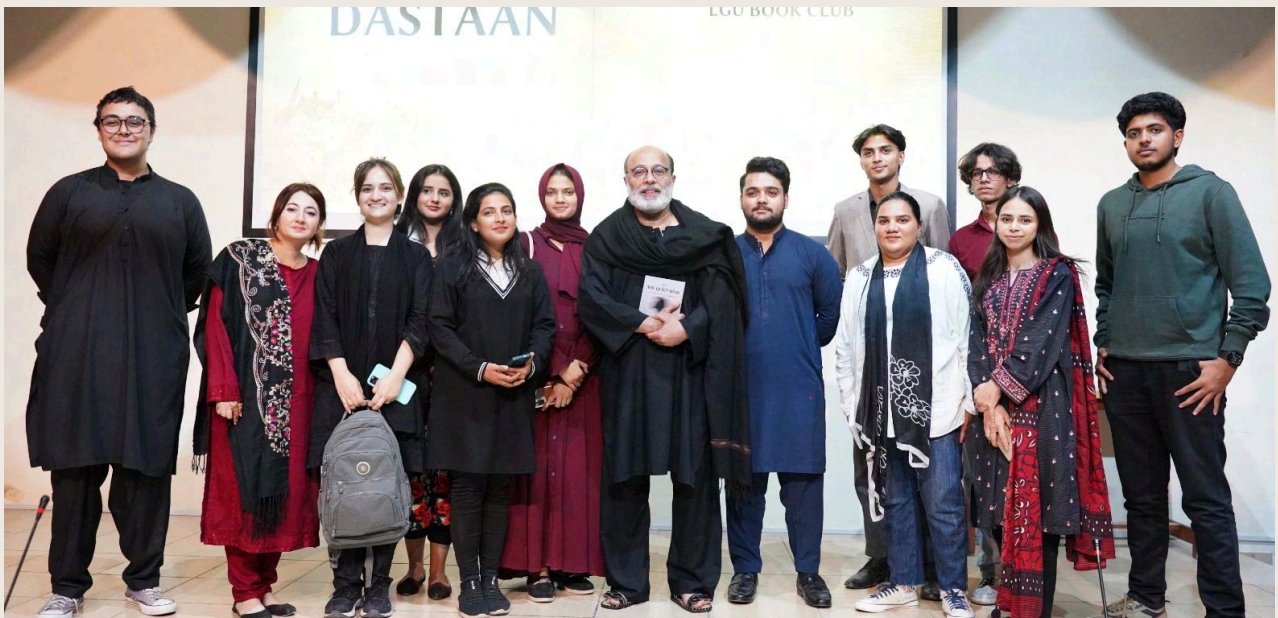
RENOWNED CONTENT CREATOR INSPIRES STUDENTS IN WORKSHOP

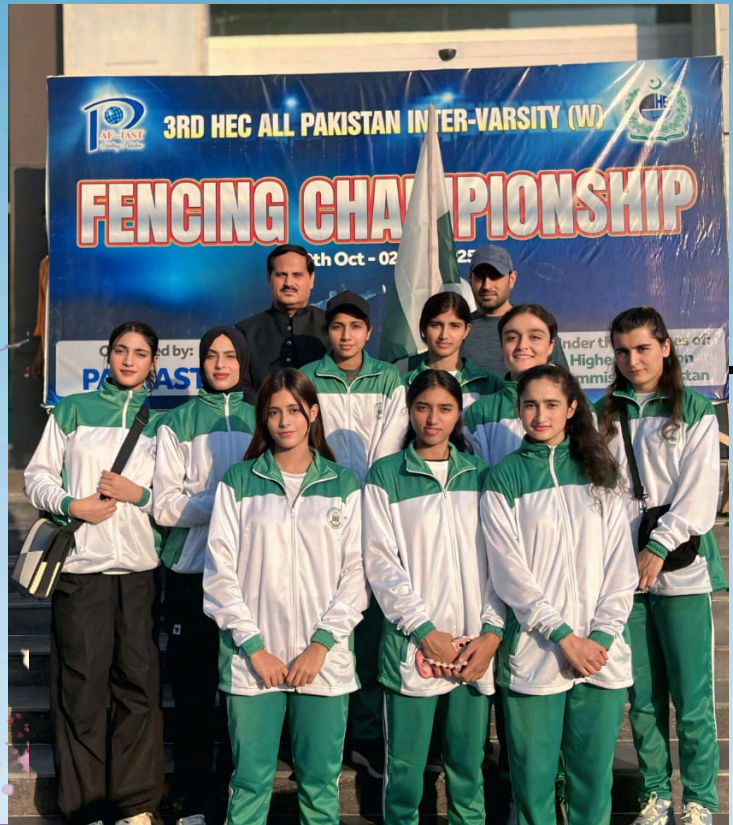
