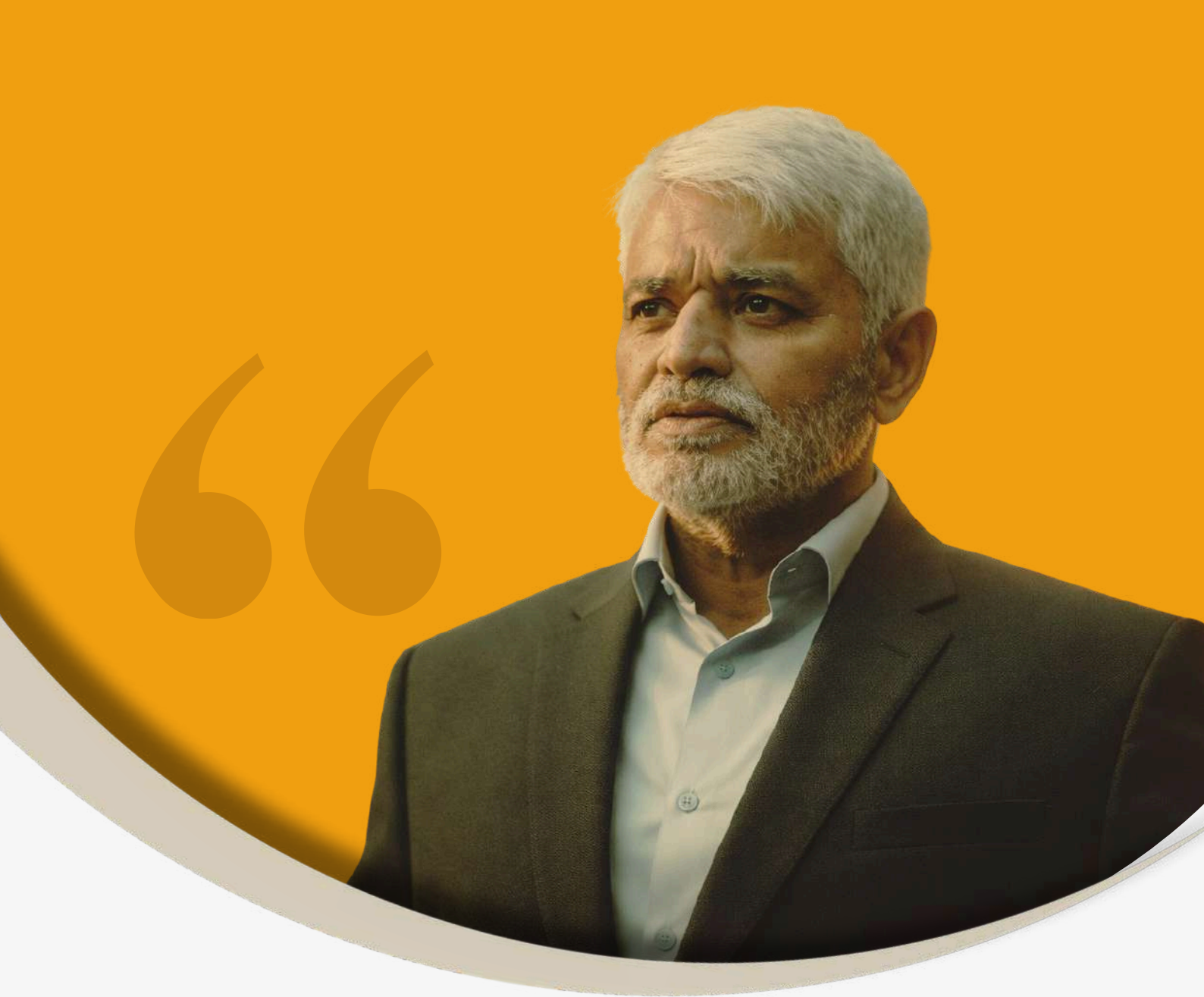

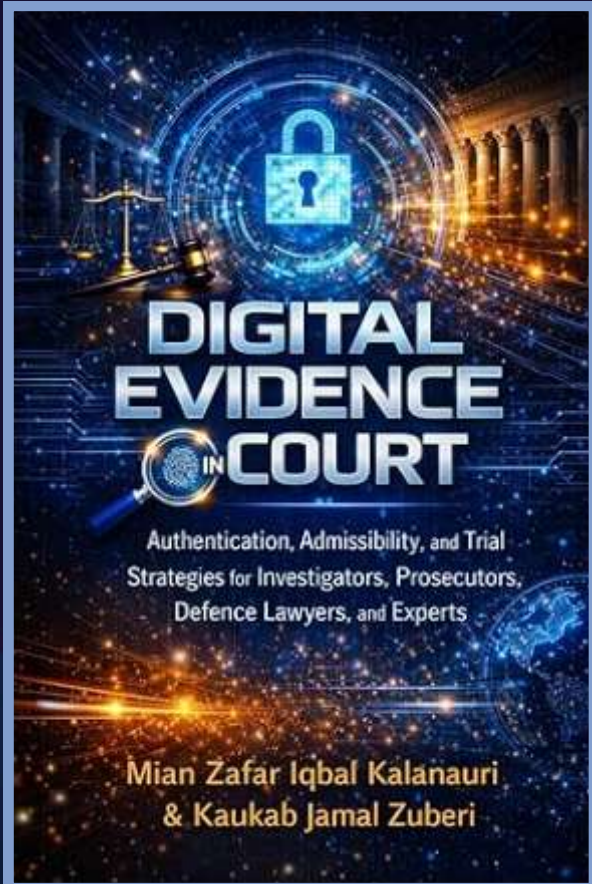


# LGU EXPLORES ACADEMIC COLLABORATION WITH UNIVERSITY OF MELBOURNE

# ASSOCIATE DEAN MR. KOKAB ZUBERI PUBLISHES FIRST BOOK ON DIGITAL EVIDENCE



Lahore Garrison University proudly announces that Mr. Kokab Zuberi, Associate Dean, Faculty of Social Sciences, has published his first book, *Digital Evidence in Court: Authentication, Admissibility, and Trial Strategies for Investigators, Prosecutors, Defence Lawyers, and Experts*, now available on Amazon. The book is co-authored with Zafar Iqbal Kalanauri and provides a practical guide to handling digital evidence in court.

The book explains how courts assess screenshots, platform exports, logs, and AI-generated material. It presents a clear framework built around three key burdens: integrity, identity, and linkage. It also addresses admissibility, chain of custody, expert testimony, and the challenges posed by AI and synthetic media.

Written for investigators, prosecutors, defence lawyers, experts, and judges, the book offers courtroom-ready tools, evidence handling standards, and practical litigation strategies for the digital age.

## Turning Surplus into Social Impact Fostering Responsible Citizenship

The Bio Serve Society at Lahore Garrison University is turning unused lab equipment into learning resources for FG schools and colleges, reflecting LGU's vision of responsible citizenship. By recognizing the needs of others and acting with empathy, the students are transforming surplus resources into meaningful educational opportunities.

Surplus benches, tables, cupboards, and stools were donated instead of discarded, helping schools build better labs and classrooms.

A team of 16 students – including the President, Vice President, Secretary, and members from Biotech, Microbiology, and Human Nutrition & Dietetics – visited schools, assessed needs, and organized a formal handover event approved by the VC, complete with banners and media coverage.

This initiative embodies responsible citizenship in action, showing how students can combine skills, initiative, and social responsibility to make a meaningful impact on their community.

## **Two-Day High-Intensity CBT Workshop Held at LGU**

The LGU Department of Psychology and the Pakistan Institute of Living and Learning hosted a workshop on February 16-17, 2026, focused on “Capacity Building in High-Intensity Cognitive Behaviour Therapy (CBT) for Breast Cancer Patients.” Aimed at MS Clinical Psychology students, the workshop enhanced skills in delivering structured CBT to breast cancer patients with comorbid depression in low-resource settings. Led by Ms. Rabia Fahad and Ms. Hamna Muqet, sessions covered clinical assessment, case formulation, and integrated psychosocial care, highlighting LGU’s commitment to mental health training and collaboration.





# PAIDAR SME Grant Window Information Session at LGU



Lahore Garrison University held an information session on the PAIDAR SME Grant Window at the Business Incubation Center, focusing on funding opportunities up to €200,000 with 50–70% matching grants for sustainable enterprises. Organized with UNIDO and EU funding, it targeted sectors like Digital Business Solutions and Clean & Green Solutions. Attendees learned about the grant application process, eligibility, and scaling strategies. LGU encourages student entrepreneurs to utilize this opportunity, emphasizing the importance of punctuality and formal business registration for eligibility.

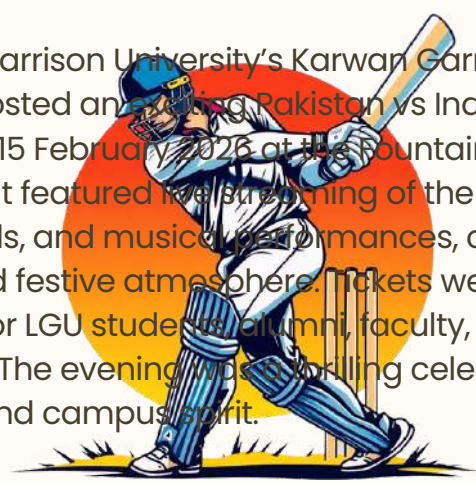




# ***PAKISTAN VS INDIA CRICKET NIGHT AT LGU***

On February 24, 2026, Dr. Bilal Siddiqui delivered a lecture at Lahore Garrison University, emphasizing that Artificial Intelligence (AI) is now integral to education. He urged faculty and students to embrace AI as a tool for enhanced learning while stressing the importance of critical thinking. Dr. Siddiqui asserted, "AI is here... but critical thinking separates us from the machine," encouraging independent analysis and questioning rather than blind reliance on AI. The session highlighted that the future will favor those who wisely use AI, guided by human judgment.
