**Q1. “I have no spur to prick the sides of my intent, but only / Vaulting ambition, which o'erleaps itself / And falls on the other.”(Macbeth).** Shakespeare's plays often explore the complexities of human nature, delving into themes of power, identity, love, and morality. Select any play from Shakespeare and analyze how these themes are developed through character, language, and dramatic structure. How do these themes reflect the socio-political and cultural concerns of Shakespeare's time, and what relevance do they hold for contemporary audiences?

**Q2. Evaluate *King Lear* as a tragedy of human suffering, endurance, and redemption.** Consider whether Lear's suffering leads to insight and self-awareness and merely reflects human helplessness. Discuss whether Shakespeare offers consolation through Lear's spiritual awakening.

**Q3. Discuss the major features of John Donne's metaphysical poetry with special reference to his use of conceits, wit, paradox, and intellectual depth.** How does Donne blend passion and reason, body and soul, to create a unique poetic style that distinguishes him from other poets of his age?"
