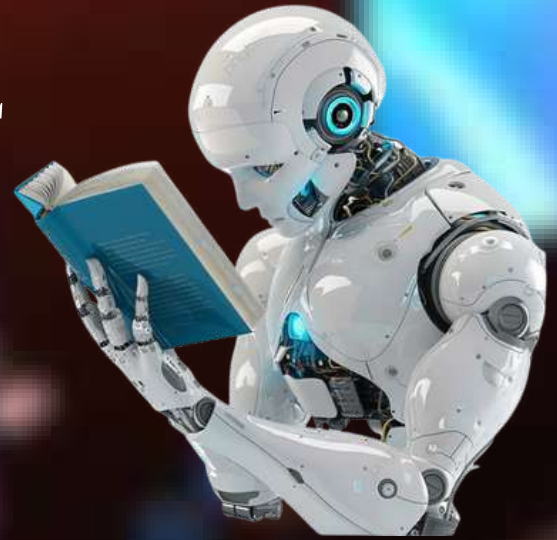

International Conference 2026: AI and the Future of English Studies — Pedagogical Innovations and Literary Translations in Global Context

LGU ACADEMIC SHARES EXPERTISE AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MELBOURNE

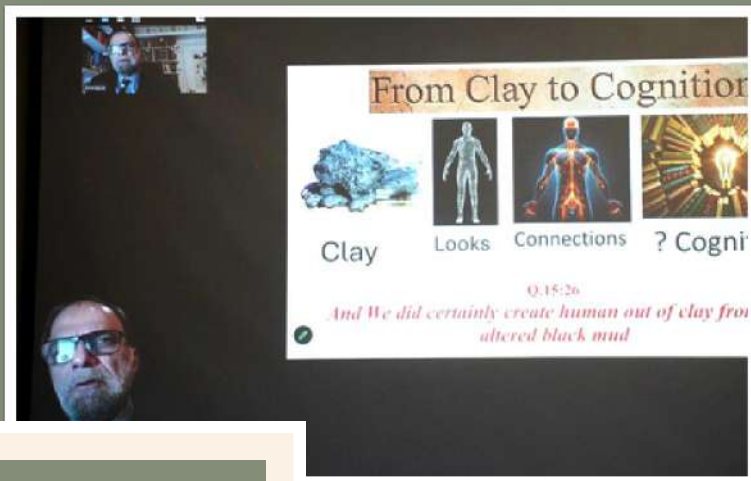
Dr Aiza Hussain Rana delivers guest lecture on AI-driven recruitment and the future of talent acquisition.

An unforgettable journey of adventure, discovery, and camaraderie through the scenic valleys of northern Pakistan.

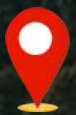
