Nauman's accomplishment reflects LGU's commitment to nurturing talent and excellence in technology and innovation.



LAHORE GARRISON UNIVERSITY AT IAUP CENTRAL ASIA CONFERENCE 2026 ALMATY, KAZAKHSTAN



Lahore Garrison University proudly participated in the prestigious International Association of University Presidents (IAUP) Central Asia Regional Conference 2026 held in Almaty, Kazakhstan. Standing tall as the only university representing Pakistan, the LGU delegation joined over 100 university leaders, international experts, and policymakers hailing from 21 countries to discuss the future of impact-driven higher education and internationalization in the region.





In his conference address, the Vice Chancellor highlighted LGU's vision for internationalization: **"Collaborate to innovate and innovate to collaborate."** Three key agreements were secured to expand LGU's global academic network:

- **Strategic MoU with SIAS University, China:** Promotes long-term collaboration for academic mobility and joint research.
- **Enhanced Student Exchange Agreement with Almaty Management University:** Facilitates credit-transfer mobility for both undergraduate and postgraduate students in Kazakhstan.
- **New partnership with Khalel Dosmukhamedov Atyrau University:** Strengthens academic and research collaboration with a leading Kazakh university.

These efforts embed LGU in the global higher education landscape, creating world-class opportunities for students and faculty, emphasizing the collaborative future of education.

LGU SIGNS MOU WITH UNIVERSITI MALAYSIA PERLIS TO STRENGTHEN INTERNATIONAL COLLABORATION



Lahore Garrison University (LGU) and Universiti Malaysia Perlis (UniMAP) signed a five-year Memorandum of Understanding on June 18, 2026, to enhance academic cooperation. The agreement, signed by LGU's Vice Chancellor Maj. Gen. Muhammad Khalil Dar and UniMAP's Vice Chancellor Dato' Prof. Ts. 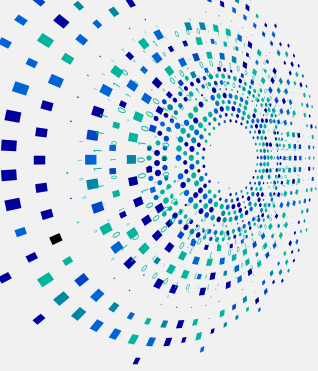


LGU ORIC STEERING COMMITTEE REVIEWS ANNUAL PROGRESS AND RESEARCH INITIATIVES



The Office of Research, Innovation and Commercialization (ORIC) at Lahore Garrison University held its Steering Committee Meeting on June 19, 2026, to assess progress in research and innovation for FY 2025-26. Representatives from academia and industry attended, with Dr. Tahir Alyas presenting an annual report on achievements in commercialization, international collaborations, and AI initiatives. 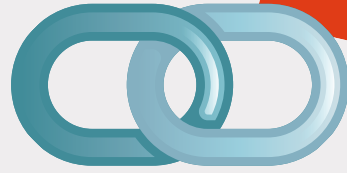

Dr. Nida Zafar Secures Consecutive International Research Grants from Norway

Dr. Nida Zafar, Chairperson and Associate Professor, Department of Psychology, Lahore Garrison University, has earned consecutive international research grants from the University of Bergen and the University of Agder, Norway, recognizing her contributions to research on digital wellbeing.
